TASKS & DUTIES:

- Talk personally to each camper in your small group.
- Give encouragement and opportunity to make a spiritual decision.
- Abide by and cooperate with camp policies, set camp tone, and monitor camper behaviors.
- Lead camper group, while providing friendship and authority.
- Lead daily devotionals, group prayers, participate in worship, and group messages.
- Be responsible for camper conduct.
- Keep campers on schedule.
- Encourage and monitor camper hygiene, cleanliness and respect of property.
- Put the well-being of campers before your own personal desires.
- Cooperate with fellow camp counselors, YouthHope staff, volunteers and counselors in training.
- Live at Camp Summit and eat meals with campers.
- Participate in raising support for the ministry.
- Perform additional tasks and duties as assigned by Camp Director and/or Assistant Camp Director.

SKILLS & REQUIREMENTS:

- Enthusiasm for the mission of YouthHope and the kids, teens and families we serve.
- Dependable, reliable, honest and trustworthy.
- Agree with YouthHope's Statement of Faith.
- Passionate about sharing Christ with children and teens.
- Must be at least 18 years old and at least one year removed from high school.
- Energetic, creative, friendly, compassionate, and dedicated.
- Ability to use positive behavior management techniques with campers.
- Able to adapt in difficult situations with safety, tact, wisdom and poise.
